How will Patty's House help Puget Sound cats?

More space at our shelter will allow us to:

- House up to 100 more cats at a time and increase adoptions significantly.
- Create a better balance between special kitties who need extra care and more easily-adoptable cats.
- House cats and kittens from multiple sources separately to reduce cross-contamination, and isolate sick cats for treatment more effectively.
- Provide alternative, less-stressful housing for cats who do not like other cats.
- Provide an onsite X-ray machine, improving our quality of veterinary care.
- Increase the number of cats we can accept from the public or shelters on short notice.
- Provide privacy, dignity and comfort for clients who are coming to us for help.
- Increase the size of our pet food bank.
- Provide additional office space for our shelter staff, volunteers and foster parents.
- Increase our storage space for cat food and supplies.
- Meet county code requirements.



First Floor features:

- **Space for over 35 more cats** via 1 large and 4 small adoption rooms, some with attached enclosed patios
- Reception desk with semi-private area for surrenders and adoptions
- Large waiting area for clients of our free spay and neuter clinic
- Expanded pet food bank
- Two ADA-compliant restrooms
- Administrative office space
- Caretaker's residence



Second Floor Features:

- **Space for over 50 more cats** via 4 cat holding rooms
- Administrative office space
- Prep area with utility sink and laundry facilities, as well as storage for supplies
- Imaging room for X-ray and ultrasound machines (which we do not currently have on site)



We've come so far! Let's go all the way.

Today, our facility has room for up to 225 short- and long-term feline residents. We also house an additional 50-250 cats and kittens in foster care, depending on the time of year

Purrfect Pals has 13 full time and 4 part time employees, plus 600+ volunteers who regularly give their time at our 12 satellite adoption centers. In 2013, volunteers logged over 10,000 hours of service and we helped 1,592 cats find loving, permanent homes.

Patty's House will allow us to increase capacity, improve services, and provide even better care for the cats in our community and their families.





Through placement and prevention programs, Purrfect Pals is making a difference!

Although our ultimate goal is to **rehabilitate** and place all cats in loving homes, many special cats with major medical needs, chronic illnesses and behavioral challenges will find that home at our **Sanctuary** for as long as they need us.

In our **Permanent Foster Program**, we match special needs cats with families who commit to caring for them long-term. Because Purrfect Pals provides lifetime veterinary care for these cats, we have been very successful placing hospice, FIV+ and FELV+ kitties in homes thanks to this program!

Our **Free Spay & Neuter Clinic** runs every week for individuals who would not otherwise have access to these services. We also offer low cost vaccines and flea treatment.

The **Community Pet Food Bank** provides free cat food and supplies to those who are struggling financially, or to caretakers of feral colonies.

Due to the cost of veterinary care, many cat lovers are faced with giving up their feline friends in times of crisis. In response, Purrfect Pals created the **Angel Fund** so they will not be faced with the unthinkable: surrender or euthanasia.

You can help us end cat homelessness in Puget Sound. *It's already happening...*

Thanks in large part to our shelter transfer program, the Everett Animal Shelter reported that ZERO healthy, adoptable cats were euthanized due to overcrowding in 2013! Your gift in support of Patty's House will help us show the world that it can be done - that every cat matters.

Will you join us on our incredible journey?

Phase One is already underway!

Renovations to our existing buildings are expected to be completed in Fall of 2014.

Phase Two is coming in 2015...

We hope to break ground on construction of Patty's House in the new year.

The total expected cost of the entire project is \$1,100,000. Contributions of all sizes are welcome, and on behalf of the kitties, we are asking you to dig deep and to be as generous as possible.
